Remember:

- Find a private area to speak with the person who is experiencing violence
- It takes a tremendous amount of courage for any person to utilize this service, acknowledge that to them.
- Ask if they want you to make a phone call for them, and only do so if they agree (or the child is a minor).
- You are not expected to have answers, merely have phone numbers available for their assistance.
- If you are at a loss, say these 3 things:
 - Are you safe?
 - Can I call someone for you?
 - I will try to do the best I can to help you.
- Self-determination is essential, especially in times of crisis. Listen non-judgmentally and allow the person to make their own choices.
